NOTES FROM DIPTFORD PARISH COUNCIL MEETING AUGUST 2025

No further news received from **Morrish Homes** regarding the building site opposite Wheat Park. It is hoped that they may attend the October Parish Council Meeting with more information.

Further improvements are hoped for in the **Playing Field**. Council is currently awaiting quotes from contractors after which we will apply to the Devon Community Foundation for funding. Our County and District Councillors are kindly providing some much needed funds towards this.

Cllr Peach has offered to be a **Parish Council representative** on the Devon Community Foundation.

It is hoped that Council will receive Gift Aided funds from HMRC soon following problems with the registration. **Any donations to the Amenity Trust are eligible for Gift Aid**. Contact the Clerk if you need more details. clerk@diptfordparishcouncil.org

Debbie Dugdall will be our new Parish Councillor, bringing our numbers back up to the required 8 members.

Whilst it is pleasing to note that the large area of **subsidence** outside White Gates has eventually been filled in, we have been asked to let our Highways Officer know when it starts to sink again. If you see large deep **potholes** on our roads and lanes, please report on the Devon County Council website under Report a Problem.

A reminder to all – please ensure that your **roadside hedges** are cut back to maintain visibility which is a legal requirement, as is keeping any **roadsigns** on or adjacent to your land free of vegetation.

Council continues to press for **improvements at Diptford Cross** junction with the hope of securing a change from Give Way to Stop.

FOOTPATH ETIQUETTE – DO's AND DON'T'S - DOGS AND ROUTES



We have recently been made aware of a number of people letting their dogs run free on the various Public Rights of Way and adjacent land in Diptford Parish.

Under the law, although dogs are viewed as a natural appendage of walkers, in fact they have NO legal rights. This may come as a surprise to some.

There are a few Public Rights of Way in the Parish — being Footpaths and one small section of Bridleway. There are absolutely NO AREAS subject to RIGHT TO ROAM. This is restricted to designated areas of Moorland, Heath and Down and does not affect ANY areas in Diptford.

All farmland is someone's working land and used to carry on farming businesses, whether by grazing animals or growing grass or crops.

Always pick up after your dog - it is an offence not to. Dog faeces can cause illness in farm animals.

Footpaths are:-

- 1 From Village Hall to Mill Lane using the fenced path there is a dog waste bin at the Hall end please use it and pick up after your dog at all times it is an offence not to.
- 2 From top of Holsome Lane through to Holsome Farm Lane. Although unfenced, you MUST keep to the legal line of the Footpath and always keep your dog under **close control**, preferably on a lead.
- 3 There is a footpath from Murtwell, again unfenced and over open farmland coming out at Rolster Bridge.
- 4 Another unfenced path runs from Greyhills on the road towards Rolster Bridge, coming out on the road to Crabadon.
- 5. The final footpath in Diptford Parish begins off the Diptford Moreleigh road, crossing farmland at Wheeldon, before crossing the lane and then coming out on the road to Curtisknowle. This then continues as an unsurfaced county road via Newhouse, coming out on the road from Gara Bridge to Moreleigh.
- 6. The only official Bridleway in the Parish runs from Broadley Woods down to Gara Bridge. Please remember that the primary users of bridleways are horses and that all motorised vehicles are illegal on such routes.

In addition to the official Rights of Way, there are a number of unsurfaced, unclassified county roads – you can call them Green Lanes – in the Parish. These include a network around the Broadley Woods, Wheeldon area and also through Larcombe towards the Harberton road.



This applies to faulty streetlights, potholes and problems of visibility though <u>landowners</u> are encouraged to keep roadsigns on their land clearly visible and to cut roadside hedges on an annual basis out of the nesting season. There are exemptions from the timing if there are road safety issues.
