Diptford Parish Council has representation on the Four Rivers Dementia Alliance and is working with the South Hams Dementia Forum run through South Hams District Council to improve the lives of people living with dementia, their carers and families in a rural community.





Dementia Friendly Parishes Around the Yealm supports people with dementia and their families in the parishes of Wembury, Yealmpton, Brixton, Holbeton, Newton & Noss with home visits, advice and information plus a variety of welcoming, friendly inclusive groups. The groups are open to everyone from any area:

Every Last Monday of the month - Free Monday Club, 10.30 to 12.30 in the Methodist Church Hall, Yealmpton. Currently run in partnership with "Life on the Edge" project, involving creative activities with a nature focus. All materials provided.

Every Tuesday morning - Gentle Exercise Classes at Yealmpton Methodist Church 10.00 to 11.00 and also 11.15 to 12.15. (£5). Free taster session.

<u>Every Wednesday morning</u> - Free Walking Group led by qualified walk leaders meets in the car park at Barton Close, Wembury at 10.30 am. There is a gentle walk with friendly company in various locations e.g. Wembury, Saltram, Jennycliff etc followed by refreshments.

<u>Every Thursday</u> - Listen and Laugh to familiar stories and poetry, 10.30 to 12.00 at the Parish Rooms, Bakery Square, Yealmpton over a cuppa. (£2). The informal library in the Parish Room is open from 10.00 to 10.30 to exchange books and you can stay on to join the group!

<u>Every First Friday of the month</u> - Free Carers Catch Up - A support group for carers 2 .00 to 3.30 at Yealmpton Methodist Church. Refreshments provided.

<u>Every Second Friday of the month</u> - Free Coffee and Chat at The Rose & Crown, Yealmpton, 2.00 to 3.30. Friendly and relaxed time to catch up.

Every Third Friday of the Month - Singing Along 2.00 to -3.30 in Yealmpton Methodist Church. (£3 towards refreshments).

(FODS)





NOTES FROM DIPTFORD PARISH COUNCIL MEETING SEPTEMBER 2025

With a number of Councillors unable to be present, Cllr Steven Parker Davidson took the Chair.

Discussion centred on the Terms of Reference for the Diptford Community Fund when originally set up. Our Clerk and Cllr Lethbridge are following up with both the Fund and with SHDC. We want to apply for funding towards further improvements to the Playing Field.

The October meeting will review the contract of our Parish Lengthsman in relation to hours and hourly rate.

Three estimates have been obtained for new or replacement equipment at the Playing Field. Cllr Crocker has dismantled, repaired and replaced the long slide which had been reported as broken. Cllr Paterson has also carried out some repairs. Their help is much appreciated.

Repairs to the Climbing Frame are currently being done by contractor which will hopefully make this safe for a time to come. However, this too will need replacing in the longer term.

Alas, there is still no update from Morrish Homes on the site opposite Wheat Park.

The next Diptford Parish Council Meeting will take place on Tuesday 21 October.


