REVD PETER AMBROSE DUNCAN WILLIS

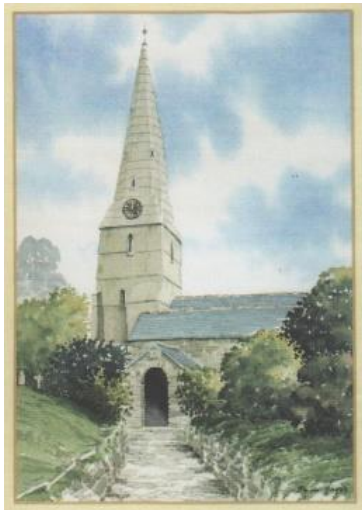
**Peter, who was a former Rector of Pembroke Tobago (1963-68);

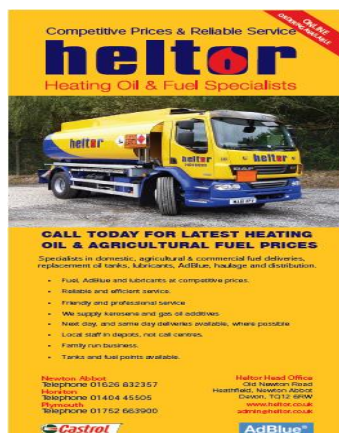

Scam Alert: Fake Parking Fine Messages

During recent Cybercrime awareness public engagement events across Devon and Cornwall, several attendees have reported receiving fraudulent parking fine notifications sent via text message and email.

How to Spot the Scam

As a general rule, real parking fines (Penalty Charge Notices) are never issued via a text or email message.

If you receive this sort of message, please look for these Red Flags:

- ❑ **Missing Details:** The message won't include your vehicle registration number, the specific car park / location, or the exact date/time of the incident.
- ❑ **False Urgency:** They use "scare tactics," threatening that the fine will double or triple if you don't pay quickly.
- ❑ **Suspicious Links:** They will urge you to click a link to "pay now." These links lead to fake websites designed to steal your bank details.

What You Should Do

- ❑ **Do Not Click:** Never click links in unexpected texts or emails.
- ❑ **Verify:** If you are worried, check with your local council or the private parking firm directly using a trusted website or an independently verified phone number. NEVER call any phone numbers included in the original message.
- ❑ **Report It:**
 - Texts: Forward the message to 7726 (it's free and alerts mobile providers).
 - Emails: Forward to report@phishing.gov.uk.
 - Fraud: Report to reportfraud.police.uk or call 0300 123 2040.

If you think you have lost money or given out sensitive financial information to scammers, immediately alert your bank / financial institution. Call them right away to inform them of the suspicious incident. You can quickly reach many UK banks' fraud departments by calling 159





NOTES FROM DIPTFORD PARISH COUNCIL MEETING JANUARY 2026

A well attended Parish Council meeting was delighted to hear that a considerable amount has been awarded from the Devon Community Fund towards the installation of new play equipment in the Playing Field which, together with the Gift Aid now received, will almost cover the quotes received. Cllr Carrol is now to take this further with Council's preferred contractor.

Further fundraising will begin shortly with a view to replacing the Climbing Frame rather than spend more on further repairs when necessary as the item is nearing end of life.

Early February will see the delivery of 10 free fruit trees from Devon Wildlife Trust, to be planted in suitable places in the Playing Field. Our Tree Warden Will has suggested a white hornbeam as our Landmark Tree, which could be used to commemorate 800 years of Diptford's Parish Church.

A wheelchair accessible bench is to be provided in the Playing Field.

Bad weather planning – DCC have confirmed that the road from Avonwick to Diptford Square remains on their secondary gritting routes. Council is to request that the road from Shorter Cross on the Totnes road to Short Cross on the Kingsbridge road via Moreleigh be added to secondary gritting routes due to the amount of traffic now using the road and number of minor accidents. We can ask but no guarantees!

Councillors remain extremely concerned at the lack of resilience in the local aeries and impossibility of mobile usage in the event of power cuts.

CLlr Parker-Davidson has arranged a **presentation** on hiring by the Parish Council, and borrowing by parishioners, of a **Thermal Imaging Camera** to use in your own home and to help spot those cold areas in your house. **At the Parish Hall on Monday 16 February at 7pm. Entry is FREE.** This presentation will show us how to use the camera so come along and find out more – see the flyer below and please do come along to the presentation.

DIPTFORD PARISH ELEEMOSYNARY CHARITY TRUST

Grants for teenagers in Diptford going on to higher or further education are available from a historic local charity that was originally created last century to benefit rural apprentices. The current Trustees now wish to broaden the eligibility and invite applications from a wider group of young people, who are resident in Diptford Parish and need financial assistance with equipment/books to support their university courses or further education including technical courses and apprenticeships.

Applications are also invited from any local parishioner who is undergoing or preparing for higher education or a further training scheme that provides a suitable life skill or employment qualification. Regular University course and accommodation costs do not qualify, but other supplementary one-off costs could be considered. Successful applicants will need to show evidence of the benefit and grant expenditure.

Applications to The Eleemosynary Charity Trust should cover the following headings:

- **Full name: and name of parent for applications from children under 16.**
- **Address: (applications can only be accepted by residents of Diptford Parish).**
- **Email & Telephone:**
- **Reason for the application providing any evidence of need, the benefit, and details of what the grant will be expended on:**
- **A proposed breakdown of grant expenditure with associated cost evidence.**

The merit of all applications will be assessed by trustees of the Eleemosynary Charity Trust on the individual's financial need and their personal benefit from a grant.

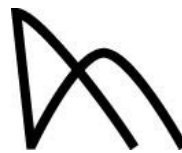
