Plastic

- ✓ All plastic bottles (squashed with lids on)
- ✓ Plastic trays and punnets **NEW!**
- ✓ Plastic pots **NEW!**
- ✓ Plastic tubs **NEW!**
- ✗ No black plastic
- ✗ No film



Metal

- ✓ Drinks cans
- ✓ Food tins
- ✓ Aerosols (empty)
- ✓ Lids from jars and bottles
- ✓ Kitchen foil
- ✓ Aluminium trays (e.g. take away)
- ✓ Aluminium tubes

Recycling Box 1



**mixed
paper**

- ✓ Newspapers and magazines
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Junk mail (no plastic)



**glass bottles
& jars**

- ✓ Bottles
- ✓ Jars/pots



Use the lid provided for your box to keep your recycling dry.
Keep paper and glass separate from each other in the box.

Recycling Box 2



cardboard

- ✓ Boxes
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard
- ✓ Brown paper

Cardboard must be less than 75cm long. Flatten and remove polystyrene & tape.



cartons

- ✓ Drink cartons
- ✓ Food cartons



batteries

- ✓ All household batteries **NEW!**
(in a bag please)



printer cartridges

- ✓ Empty printer cartridges **NEW!**
(in a bag please)

Use the lid provided for your box to keep your recycling dry.
Take larger cardboard to your local recycling centre.
